

INFRASTRUCTURE

PG Clinic- Fully equipped PG clinic with state of art dental chairs, advanced maxillofacial imaging equipment including CBCT. Extensive training is provided in specialized field of Orofacial pain, oral mucosal lesions, oral cancers, maxillofacial pathology and forensic odontology.

UG Clinic- Equipped with all basic diagnostic facilities. The subject of OMR is taught in the third year and fourth year BDS. The course involves didactic lectures and clinical postings. The total number of lecture hours is 60. Clinical postings of 1 month are held in fourth BDS and Internship each. Total number of clinical hours a student needs to attend is 250 hours. During the postings, students take case histories, examine patients and formulate a diagnosis and treatment plan. They are also trained in taking intraoral radiographs and interpreting them. They are also required to submit a detailed case report on the special case allotted. Three internal tests and one pre university examination are conducted in the subject before University examination. End posting clinical examination is also held at the end of the posting.

Besides this, the department is also providing radiology facilities for the clinical and research work to the postgraduate students in other branches and the faculty.

Special clinic- The department runs following special clinics

- Oral Cancer and Precancer detection clinic – In association with Oral Pathology Department
- Triple O clinic - In association with Oral Surgery and Oral Pathology Department
- Orofacial pain clinic- In association with Oral Surgery Department
