Prof NASEEM SHAH

Dr. Naseem Shah is the Former Professor & Head, Department of Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics and Chief of the Centre for Dental Education & Research, All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) at New Delhi. She is a graduate and postgraduate from Govt. Dental College and Hospital, Mumbai.

She is one of the Founder Members of the Indian Endodontic Society and Founder Editor of “Endodontology”, an official publication of Indian Endodontic Society. She was the President of Indian Endodontic Society, Federation of Operative Dentistry of India and Indian Society for Dental Research.

She is the Founder Director of WHO Collaborating Center for Oral Health Promotion and the National Center of Excellence for implementation of National Oral Health Programme of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India at AIIMS.

She has 170 research publications, 24 research projects, 35 postgraduate research projects, 5 books (Co-edited), chapters in 8 books, with 3527 citations and h-index of 35. She has presented scientific lectures in over 90 national and international conferences. She was one of the Co-authors of “National Guidelines for Tobacco Cessation” and was part of “National Commission on Macroeconomics and Health”, a Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Ministry of Finance, Govt of India and contributed a chapter on Oral Disease burden in India.

She has done extensive work in the field of “Regenerative Endodontics”. Her innovation, “SealBio”, a novel, non-obturation regenerative technique of endodontic treatment” has been awarded the US and Australian patents. She has been practicing a minimally invasive surgical technique “Surgical fenestration” for large periapical lesions since 1995 with successful outcome.



DR. NAMITA KALRA

Dr. Namita Kalra is Professor and Head, Department of Paedodontics and Preventive Dentistry, University College of Medical Sciences (University of Delhi) and G.T.B. Hospital. She is the founder professor for the postgraduate programme in Paedodontics and Preventive dentistry and her department is the first among govt institutions in Delhi to start the postgraduate programme in paedodontics and preventive dentistry. With a rich teaching experience of 43 years, she has guided several PG and PhD students. She completed her BDS from GDC, Patiala and PG from PGIMER, Chandigarh in the year 1984.

She has been awarded with several honours including FNAMS in 2021, Delhi State Award by the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi for contribution in the field of Paedodontics and Preventive Dentistry in 2013, Best Doctor Award in the Department of Paedodontics and Preventive Dentistry on the occasion of Doctors' Day in 2012, Distinguished Women Award by Indian Society of Paedodontics and Preventive Dentistry in March, 2020, Commonwealth Academic Staff Fellowship in Paedodontics at Department of Paediatric Dentistry, University of Glasgow Dental School, Scotland. She is member of several societies and has been delivering guest lectures worldwide. With over 100 publications to her credit, she has also supervised around 30 thesis dissertations and 4 books. She has also organised 23rd National Annual Conference of Indian Society of Paedodontics and Preventive Dentistry as Chairperson of Scientific Committee on 13th-14th Jan 2002.

Non-pharmacological management of paedodontic patients

Enamel hypoplasia in young children

Pediatric endodontics, Management of trauma to dentition

Dental care for handicapped child patients

Simple and ingenious methods of child motivation, Pain control for difficult patients

Currently she heads the Dept of Oral Pathology at one of the most prestigious dental colleges of India, Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences, New Delhi from November 2010 till date.
